As the Thanet & East Kent Insider reported in the edition of 14th August last year, Kent International airport at Manston is a "key driver for economic regeneration". The study we quoted then concluded that "for every million passengers (workload units), European airports support around 2,950 jobs nationally, 2,000 jobs regionally, or 1,425 jobs sub regionally."
