





Press Release Manston Lorry Park

As a result of the French ban on UK arrivals imposed last Sunday, Manston Airport was brought into use yesterday as a temporary HGV car park. Many lorry drivers arrived at Manston disorientated, hungry and sorely missing their families where they were expecting to be for Christmas.

Car Parks are not designed to accommodate aeroplanes and airports are not built to welcome thousands of lorries on their runway.

Although the phases of Operation Fennel were implemented relatively smoothly as planned, it was clear on Tuesday evening that there was considerable stress and anxiety suffered by lorry drivers stranded in Dover, on the M20 and at Manston.
